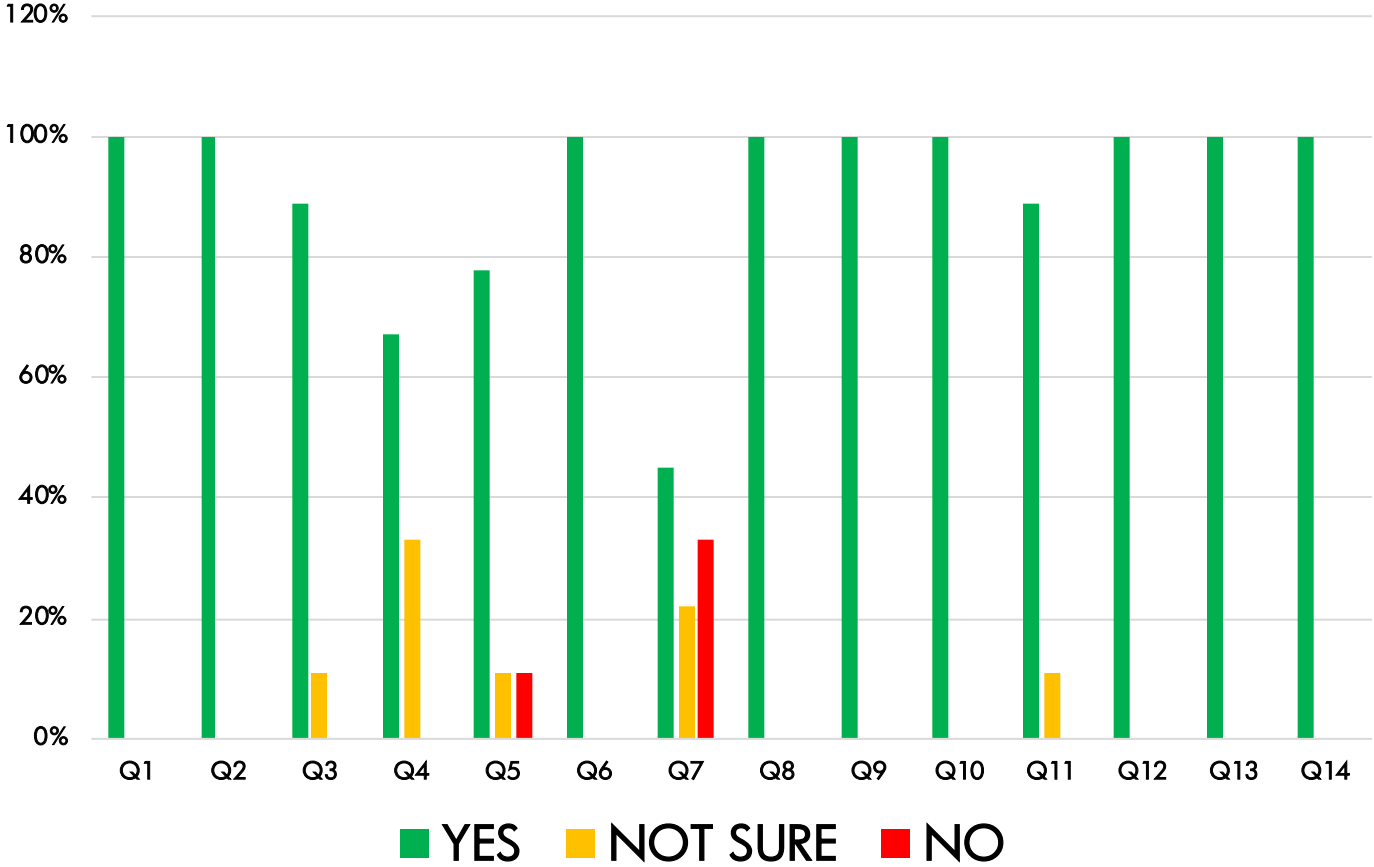


# Results of Parent View Questionnaire Carried Out in November 2018

## Pupil Voice Feedback - November 2018



- Q1 I know my teachers are glad to see me every day.
- Q2 I learn new things.
- Q3 I know who to talk to if I have a problem
- Q4 Children are friendly at school.
- Q5 I know my class and school rules.
- Q6 My teachers are interested in what I think and say.
- Q7 I look at the school web site when I am at home.
- Q8 My school helps me to stay healthy.
- Q9 Lessons are fun and interesting.
- Q10 My school encourages me to do things by myself.
- Q11 I want to come to school every day.
- Q12 My teacher explains how I can improve my work.
- Q13 I feel safe at school.
- Q14 I work hard at school.

# Key Points for Action

## Q3: I know who to talk to if I have a problem

- Mrs. Harding has had NDCS 'Healthy Minds' training to work with individual children.
- Share this with children on Pupil Notice Board.
- Worry Box – established (and used). Keep this as a high profile. Anonymous feedback through Pupil Notice Board.

## Q4: Children are friendly at school.

- School took part in National Bullying Week - raised profile.
- KS2 children made posters to display around school.
- Worry Box used – discussion as a staff & with School Council.

## Q5: I know my class and school rules.

- Class work – discussions in PHSE.

## Q7: I look at the school web site when I am at home.

- Staff training on web site – share staff ideas & skills.
- Involve School Council – ask for suggestions.
- More information on web site shared with parents & children.

## Q11: I want to come to school every day.

- Restore regular class visits out (new bus due for delivery Feb. 2019).
- *Loss of mini bus has impacted on our ability to provide enhanced curriculum – visits/first hand experiences.*
