What is BUG CLUB?



Bug Club is your core reading programme from Reception through to Year 6 (4-11-year olds). It is an online resource that families can access from home on a laptop, PC or Tablet.

It has over 590 finely levelled titles, available in print and eBook format and a unique online learning platform with in-built assessments.

It has been researched and designed to appeal to 21st century children, combining books children will want to read with an online reading world complete with virtual rewards.

How can you access this resource at home?

Children each have their own log on fro BUG CLUB.

This will allow them to access the online library of various reading books. Your child then has an allocated list of books to read and respond to questions. On completion of each book they will earn virtual rewards. Each class teacher will be able to track your child's progress and share their success in school.

Will I have to pay?

No. This is FREE to you because we believe that having access to quality reading books at home helps to improve children's reading.

School pays an annual subscription of £425 for our families to access this resource. Currently there are very families using this and we would like to remind families that this is a free resource available to everyone.
